Appendix A: Specific requirements for the facility Vankiva (HKC and ÅVC) – recycling centre

- The maximum speed throughout the area is 30 km/h, unless otherwise stated. Beware of crossing vehicles!
- Be aware of and adhere to signs, guardrails, and barriers.
- The facility contains risk areas. In areas with increased safety risk, signs provide additional information about protection zones, protective clothing, and safety equipment. For inquiries about clothing and protective equipment requirements, contact the facility manager.
- Vehicles that have been driven in landfill areas and on the surface of contaminated material must drive through a tyre wash before leaving.
- Tipping outside of the designated tipping area is strictly prohibited. If you are uncertain, contact the weighing staff.
- Photography and filming in the area is permitted only after seeking the permission of the recipient responsible for the visitor.
- The removal of equipment or material from the area is strictly prohibited. This is considered as theft and will be reported to the police.
- Work attire must include at least safety shoes with puncture protection and high-visibility upper body clothing meeting Class 2 standards (EN ISO 20471 and CE marked). Certain tasks and areas may require additional protective clothing and equipment as indicated by signs. For questions about clothing and protective equipment requirements, contact the facility manager.
- Visitors/contractors staying on the premises must wear safety shoes with puncture protection and a reflective vest or high-visibility upper body clothing meeting at least Class 2 standards (EN ISO 20471 and CE marked). If additional protective clothing and equipment are required, HMAB personnel will inform you during the visit or before work begins.
- Work requiring permission must have approval before commencement.

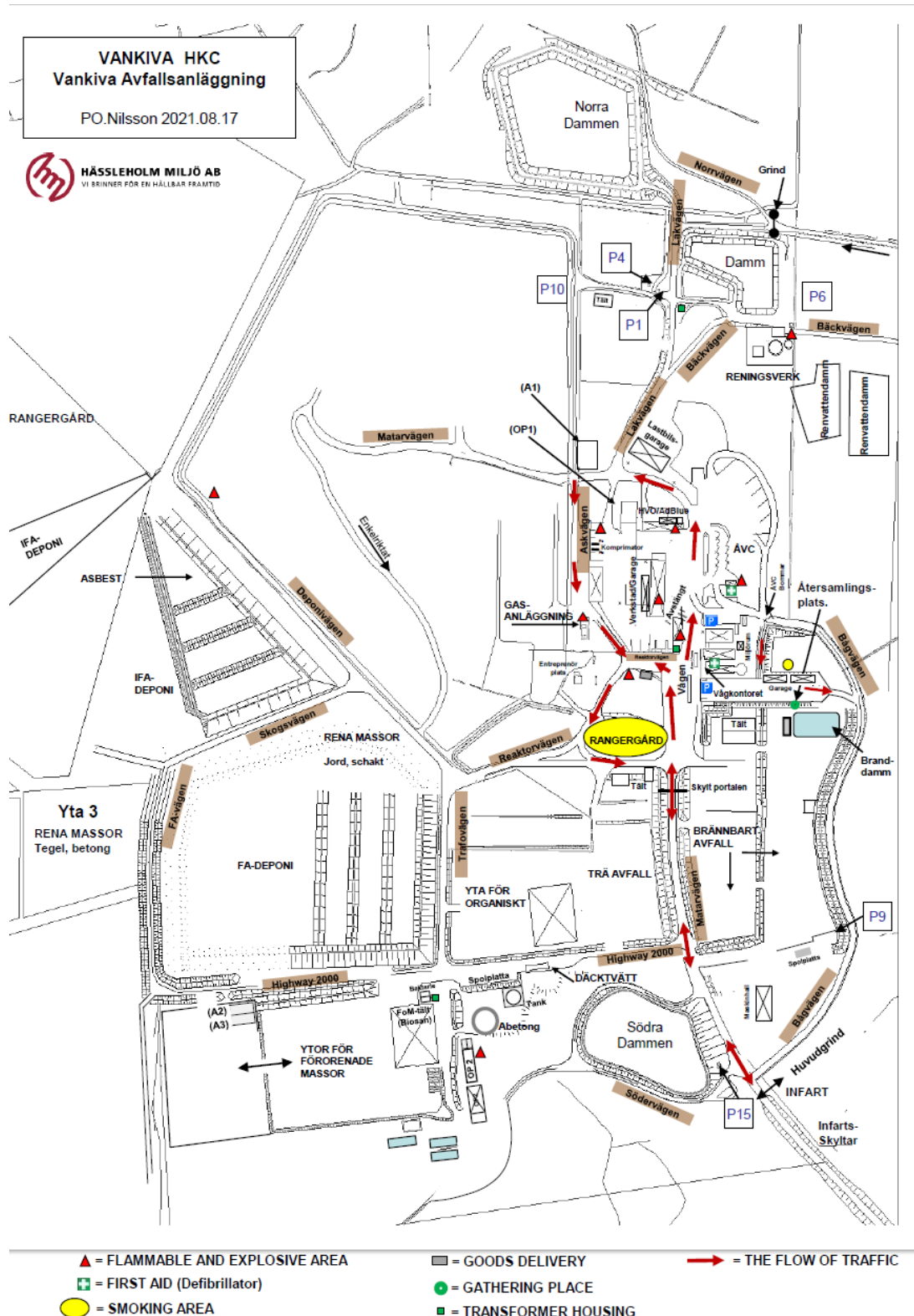


- HMAB is not responsible for accompanying children. Children can easily get injured and should stay in the vehicle on the premises.
